## Year 9 and 10 see Gala Performance of Much Ado About Nothing

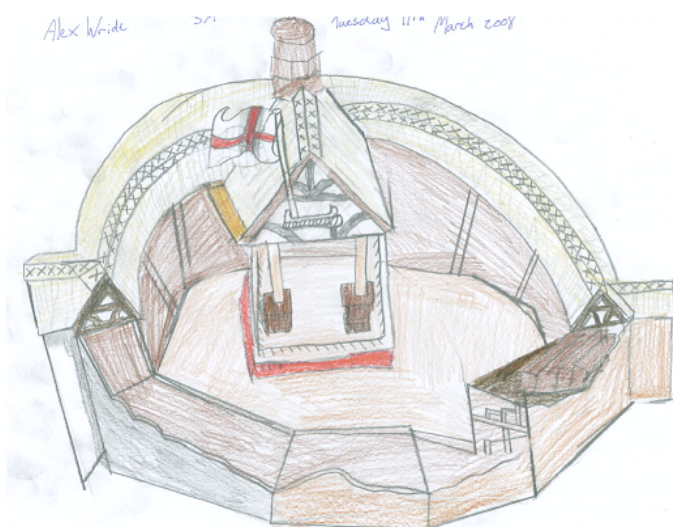

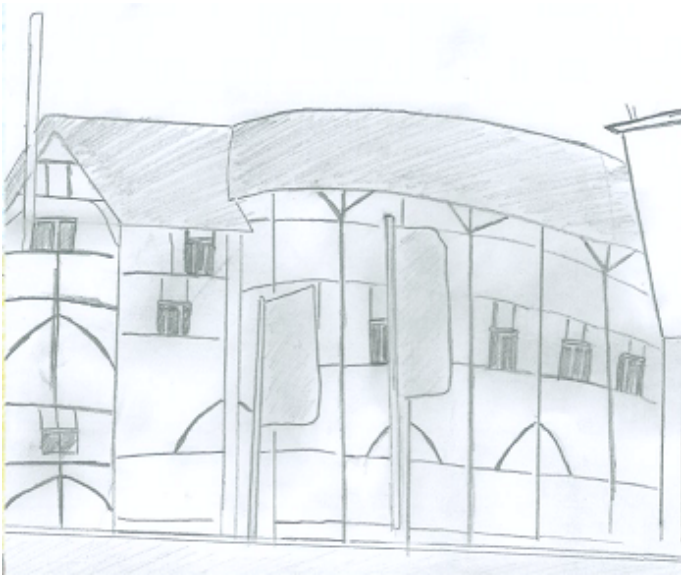
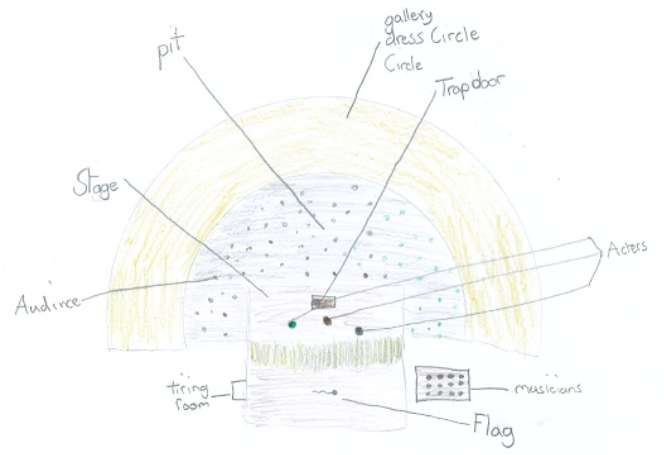
