Forest School 2022-23 for KS2, Year 7 and Year 8

Dear Parents and Carers,

I am excited to share with you that from September 2022, students in KS2, Year 7 and Year 8 will be attending Forest School sessions as part of their school timetable. Caroline Twomey, our qualified Forest School Lead, will be running these sessions in our newly developed Forest School area. When adding Forest School to the students' timetables, the Senior Management Team have ensured that students will still receive full coverage of all subjects in the curriculum. One-to-one therapy will continue to go ahead during Forest School sessions.

Each class in the year group will alternate between Forest School and another subject on a half termly basis throughout the academic year. We will provide you with more information nearer the time but thought it wise to notify you in advance in case you need to purchase any of the kit list on the next page.

Forest Schools offer a unique educational experience using an outdoor environment as a classroom. It is a student-centred learning process, that offers opportunities for holistic growth through regular sessions. It is a long-term program that supports play, exploration and supported risk taking. Activities can include team games, learning about nature, denbuilding, the use of hand tools, fire-lighting and much more.

It will be a fantastic opportunity for the students to experience the many benefits of Forest School including; increased confidence, social skills, communication, motivation, physical skills as well as knowledge and understanding of nature and the environment.
