**By Car:** From the M25 leave at junction 6 and follow the A25 towards Westerham until you see a viaduct crossing the main road. Turn right at the lights immediately before the viaduct into Woodhurst Lane. After about one mile the road opens out into common land and the school stand back off Mill Lane on your right.

**By Train:** Hurst Green station is just 300 metres from the school. There are regular trains from London and East Grinstead.

## Pre Admission Assessment

All students are admitted to Moor House School and College following a multi-disciplinary assessment to ascertain their needs and to ensure that we are the right school for them.

Once we have discussed your child's needs with you and received your child's documents we will make a decision to invite your child for an assessment if we feel that we are likely to be able to meet their needs. We may invite you in for a Pre Assessment visit to discuss your child's needs further prior to making a decision to offer a Pre Admissions Assessment.

A Pre Admission Assessment at Moor House School & College takes place over 1 day and includes the following;

- full clinical assessment by a Highly Specialist Speech and Language Therapist
- full clinical assessment by an Occupational Therapist
- an educational assessment through class placement and feedback from Specialist Teacher
- Maths and Literacy assessment
- structured observation in dining room, playground and after school time

Following the assessment you will receive:

- clinical feedback including an explanation of formal assessments and the predicted content of the assessment report
- comprehensive multi-disciplinary detailed report including recommendations for educational provision.
