What is covered and how is this different from the original multi skills course?

1. Health and Safety (1 credit) – Compulsory unit

Option units agreed:

1. Developing Construction painting skills (4 credits);
 2. Fitting units of interiors (1 credit)
 3. Using Painting Skills for Interior Ceilings and Walls (3 credits)
 4. Know how to Produce Basic Woodworking Joints (3 credits)
 5. Basic Tiling (Equipment and Materials) – (1 credit)
- ▶ This then equates to 13 Credits needed for the Full Certificate in Level 1 Construction skills – Qualification NOCN
