## **RE: Spring Ball**

It is with great excitement that we write to you to invite your son/ daughter to join us at our Moor House College Spring Ball, which will take place at **Westerham Golf Club on Tuesday 26 March 2024.**

Please note there will be an alcoholic and non-alcoholic welcome drink available on the night.

## **Transport and timings**

We will arrange the transport to and from the venue. Day students will have the option to go home at the end of the day and return in readiness for the transport to the venue or stay and get ready with their friends at Moor House. **Transport will leave for the venue at 6pm.** If you wish to take your son/daughter directly to the venue, the ball begins at 6.30pm.

Please note due to the partner college still running their normal lessons, MHC will finish at the normal time on that day. Unfortunately, we are not able to finish earlier or give permission for students to leave earlier for any appointments.

**The ball will finish at 11pm.** Day students will return from the venue with residential students back to MHC. Parents will need to arrange transport home after their return to MHC at 11.30pm. Alternatively, Parents can collect straight from the Venue at 11pm if this is more convenient. Please let us know your preference prior to the event.

### **Welcome Drink**

Students over 18 will be offered a welcome drink on arrival at the venue. This drink will be a small **glass of Prosecco**. (Please note that if your son/ daughter is over 18 and would like to receive a glass of Prosecco as their welcome drink at the event, they must ensure that both parents/ carer and student have signed the MHC Alcohol charter prior to the event and returned to Mrs van Niekerk).
