I'm inviting you to book your child's seasonal COVID-19 vaccination. This is because their NHS record suggests they may be at increased risk due to a health condition or medical treatment.

Go to www.nhs.uk/get-covid-vaccine for a list of eligible health conditions and treatments. A healthcare professional will check that vaccination is suitable for your child at their appointment.

Please use any of the booking options below unless you've already arranged your child's vaccination.

How to get your child's COVID-19 vaccination

- Book online at www.nhs.uk/book-covid – Answer 'Yes' or 'I think I might be' at high risk (on behalf of your child)
- Visit www.nhs.uk/covid-walk-in to find your nearest COVID-19 vaccination walk-in site.

If you need support

- If you can't get online, phone 119 for help arranging their vaccination.

If your child usually gets their care at home, please contact their GP surgery to arrange a home visit with a local NHS service. Go to www.england.nhs.uk/local-covid-19-vaccination-contacts if your child's GP surgery is unable to help.

COVID-19 vaccination has a proven safety record. It gives better protection than any immunity gained from a previous infection.

COVID-19 spreads more easily in winter. Even if your child has been vaccinated before, it's important they get the protection they need because viruses change, and protection fades over time.
