- 3) **Photographs** - in a group you will look at photographs and tell me about them.

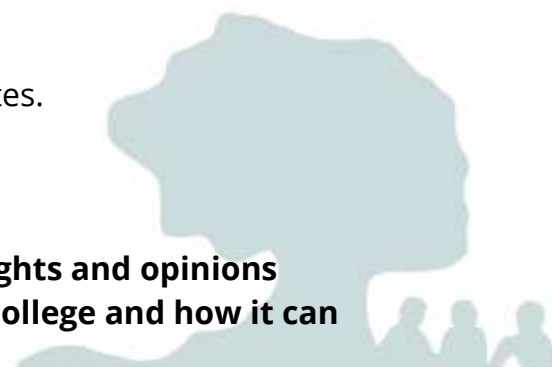
How long will it take?
