Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope this message finds you well. We are writing to bring your attention to an important aspect of our school's uniform policy, specifically regarding the appropriateness of skirt lengths.

We understand that students like to express their personal style, and we fully support individuality. However, as part of fostering a respectful and professional learning environment, we ask that students adhere to the guidelines that ensure all attire is appropriate for the school setting. Recently, there has been an increase in the number of students wearing skirts that do not meet the required length. To clarify, skirts must be of a length that reaches at least mid-thigh when seated and just above the knee when standing. They should not be skin tight, mini or bodycon style. Furthermore, as the weather is changing students should be wearing tights or leggings under a skirt that adheres to these guidelines. This is in place to maintain a sense of professionalism and respect within the school community, as well as to keep our young people safe.

We kindly ask for your support in ensuring your child follows this policy. Before your child leaves for school, please take a moment to check that their attire is appropriate for the school environment. If your child arrives to school wearing a skirt that is too short, after sufficient warning we will be asking them to change into a spare school skirt that we have onsite.

Thank you for your cooperation and continued support in helping us create a positive and safe atmosphere for all students.
